One of British music's most prolific and high-profile acts right now - Stormzy - joins Jonathan for a chat and more fun and games with some other famous faces.

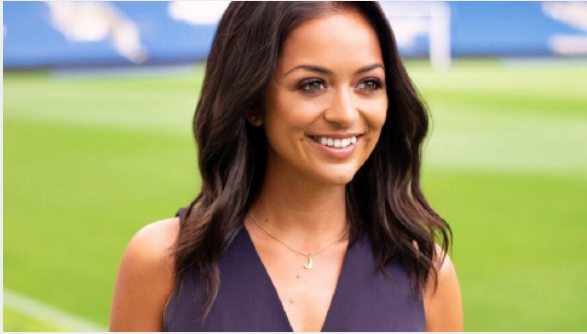
