Waco Untold: The British Stories
Full series drop on ITVX on Thursday 13th April

Using unseen archive and exclusive interviews, this documentary series explores the untold story of the British contingent of David Koresh's Branch Davidian cult.

The two-part series looks at how US law enforcement in Waco, Texas in 1993 came up against an extreme religious sect known as the Branch Davidians - what should have been a standard raid to execute an arrest warrant instead became the longest-running non-military siege in US history and resulted in an apocalyptic fire that would kill many.

One fact is rarely acknowledged within this well-known tragedy - that one third of Koresh's Branch Davidian secy were British. 30 years on, this documentary series will shed new light on the experiences of the survivors of the fire, the victims of the disaster, and the families who feel that their voices have been forgotten in history.

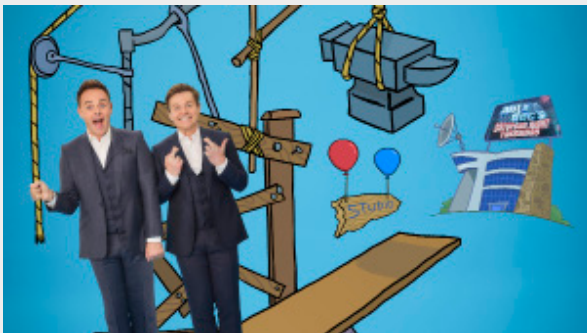
