Mr Bates vs The Post Office



A new four-part series written by acclaimed screenwriter Gwyneth Hughes tells the story of one of the greatest miscarriages of justice in British legal history.

Hundreds of innocent subpostmasters and postmistresses were wrongly accused of theft, fraud and false accounting due to a defective IT system - many of the wronged workers were prosecuted, some of whom were imprisoned for crimes they never committed, and their lives were irreparably ruined by the scandal.

Toby Jones will play Alan Bates while Monica Dolan, Julie Hesmondhalgh, Alex Jennings, Ian Hart, Lia Williams, Will Mellor, Clare Calbraith, Shaun Dooley, Amit Shah, Lesley Nicol, Adam James and Katherine Kelly also join the cast.

Between 2000 and 2013, the Post Office held thousands of its own subpostmasters and postmistresses liable for financial discrepancies thrown up by Horizon, its hugely expensive but unreliable computerised accounting system - despite warnings that the system was flawed, the Post Office relentlessly pursued the subpostmasters and postmistresses, telling many of them that they were the only ones having problems with Horizon.

Of those affected by the faulty IT system, 736 were prosecuted and hundreds more lost livelihoods, homes and life savings because they paid back money that the Post Office claimed was missing. Several went to prison - some while pregnant or with young children - many were shunned by their communities, and some have since died before they could find any justice.

The drama will tell how, in 2009, a group of subpostmasters from across the UK decided that enough was enough and formed the Justice For Subpostmasters Alliance.

The BRIT Awards 2024 with Mastercard takes place on Saturday the 2nd of March, continuing its primetime slot on ITV1 and IT VX at The O2 Arena following the huge success of the 2023 show moving to the weekend for the first time ever.

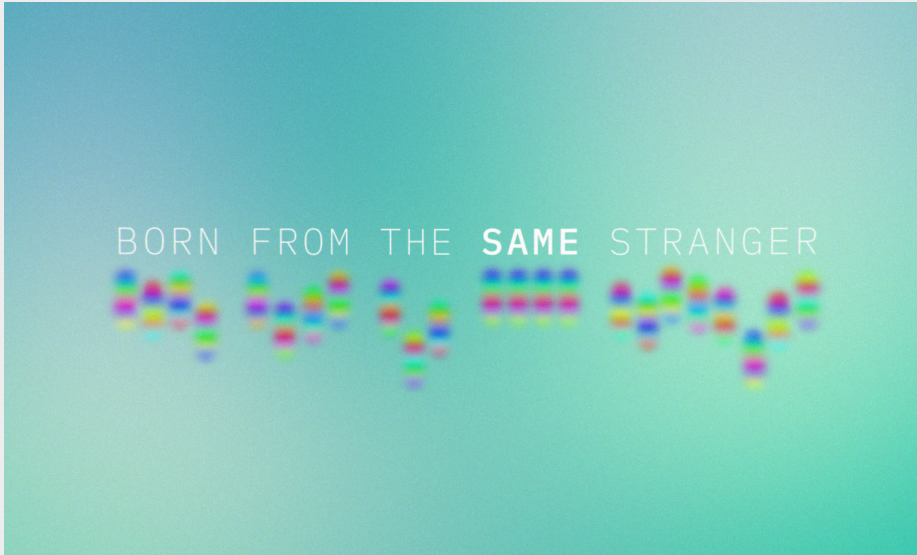

Born from the Same Stranger



Every person born from a donor might have multiple siblings they had no idea existed - now a brand-new series follows a group of donor-conceived people as they open this Pandora's Box.

The series follows the incredible stories of people who yearn to find their unknown blood relations and solve mysteries about their identities - from the award-winning Wall To Wall Media team behind ITV's Long Lost Family, this series joins searchers as they aim to be united with potentially a host of brothers and sisters with one thing in common - their anonymous biological donor.

As their journeys unfold and each clue is pursued, their detective work will be supported every step of the way by DNA technology, professional genealogists and intermediaries, and an online cohort of self-taught internet sleuths - this ready-made and organic social media community of donor-conceived experts, many of whom have already pursued their own personal searches, will be on hand to advise, encourage, offer tips and guidance and share their own extraordinary experiences.

The programme is being made as a UK law change takes effect in 2023 which sees donor anonymity disappear and anyone conceived by donation after 2005 be able to apply to find out more details about their identity as soon as they turn 18 - as of November 2023, the Human Fertilisation and Embryology Authority are proposing further changes to allow donor-conceived children to have their donor's details from the moment they are born. They have acknowledged that the law can't keep up with the reality of people tracing donors independently, and as the series will reveal, those born earlier than 2005 are searching using a combination of easily accessible DNA testing, genetic genealogy and social media advice. It's not an easy journey either - they come up against barriers and ethical dilemmas as they pursue their desire to know more about where they come from.

The series uncovers intimate stories that include meeting a woman whose donor's sperm was delivered across the world in her great aunt's hand luggage, and a brother and sister who've discovered they're two of 21 siblings and counting - it also captures donor-conceived people being united with their newfound relatives and explores the effects of nature and nurture on who we are.

With the domestic centrepiece final held at Wembley on the 25th of May, 2024, Premier League and Championship clubs join the competition from the Third Round with clubs lower in the pyramid hoping to face up to domestic giants.

2022 saw Grimsby Town become the first fourth-tier club in 32 years to make the quarter-finals, Sheffield United beat Ryan Reynolds's Wrexham in a dramatic game on their run to the semis, and Manchester City lift the trophy for the seventh time in a clash of the Manchester titans with bitter rivals United at Wembley.
