The drama will depict the stealthy and surreptitious invasion of the land our farmer cherishes with devastating consequences as his livelihood, homestead and family life are threatened by local county lines drugs dealers who are essentially urban gangs using the British countryside as a field of operations and moving drugs and money between their inner-city hubs and provincial areas.

Playing Nice



A psychological thriller adapted by Malpractice writer Grace Ofori-Attah from the best-selling novel by British thriller author JP Delaney, with Kate Hewitt (One Day) directing all episodes.

BAFTA-nominated James Norton (Happy Valley, A Little Life, Nowhere Special), BAFTA-nominated Niamh Algar (Mary and George, The Virtues, Raised By Wolves, The Wonder, Calm With Horses), Olivier-nominated James McArdle (Sexy Beast, The Mare of Easttown, Life After Life) and BIFA-nominated Jessica Brown Findlay (The Flatshare, Life After Life, Black Mirror, Downton Abbey) all take leading roles in the limited series.

As Pete and Maddie are stretched to breaking point, they realise that they will stop at nothing to keep their family together.

Vera Series 14



Renowned film, theatre, and television actress Brenda Blethyn OBE makes an emotional return for the 14th and final series of ITV's popular crime drama.

Spanning two epic feature-length episodes, these new stories entitled *Inside* and *The Dark Wives*, intertwine gripping murder mysteries with the heartfelt narrative of Vera's personal journey.

Filmed in and around the North East, the strong ensemble cast reunited with Brenda includes David Leon as DI Joe Ashworth, Jon Morrison as DC Kenny Lockhart, Riley Jones as DC Mark Edwards, Sarah Kameela Impey as pathologist Dr Paula Bennett, and Rhiannon Clements as DC Steph Duncan.

A four-part drama depicting the life of Cary Grant, Hollywood's greatest leading man, and starring Jason Isaacs in the leading role.

Born in Bristol in England in 1904 to parents Elsie and Elias, Archie tells the story of a young Archibald Alexander Leach's troubled childhood and how extreme poverty, his father's adultery and the loss of his older brother John tore the family apart and sent his loving mother into a downward spiral of grief and depression - Jeff Pope's scripts reveal how deceit, cruelty, and one overpowering lie shaped Archie's life.

At 14, Archie auditioned for the music hall act the Bob Pender Troupe - a band of acrobats, stilt walkers, clown and comedians - after seeing them perform at the Bristol Hippodrome. Lean and athletic, he learned the art of stilt walking - when the troupe went on tour to the US, teenage Archie was intoxicated by the land of opportunity.

Believing he had no family to return to in the UK, Archie decided to stay in the US to try to make his way in showbusiness - with no thoughts of acting, a chance meeting with the comedian George Burns helped him find his first footing on the acting ladder and a contract with a movie studio who felt he needed to change his name, and Cary Grant was born.

The drama intercuts with scenes from 1961 when at the height of his fame living in Benedict Canyon, Los Angeles, the legendary actor was breaking all box office records but desperately unhappy in his private life. With two failed marriages behind him, he began to woo a young actress he'd seen on a TV show called Dyan Cannon.

33 years his junior, Dyan didn't initially fall for his charms turning down his attempts to meet because she didn't feel they could ever be a match. Dashing handsome, suave and sophisticated, Cary continued to pursue her, with introductions to his famous friends, until they eventually wed in Las Vegas in 1965.

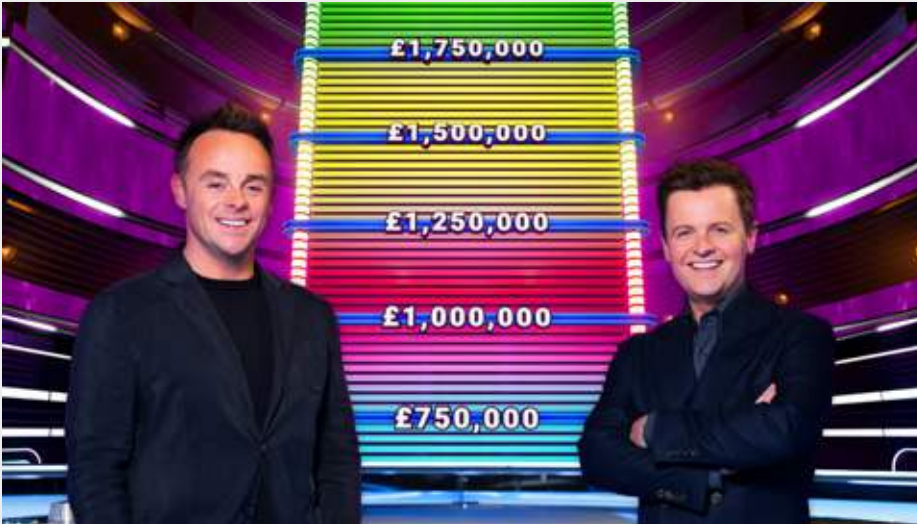

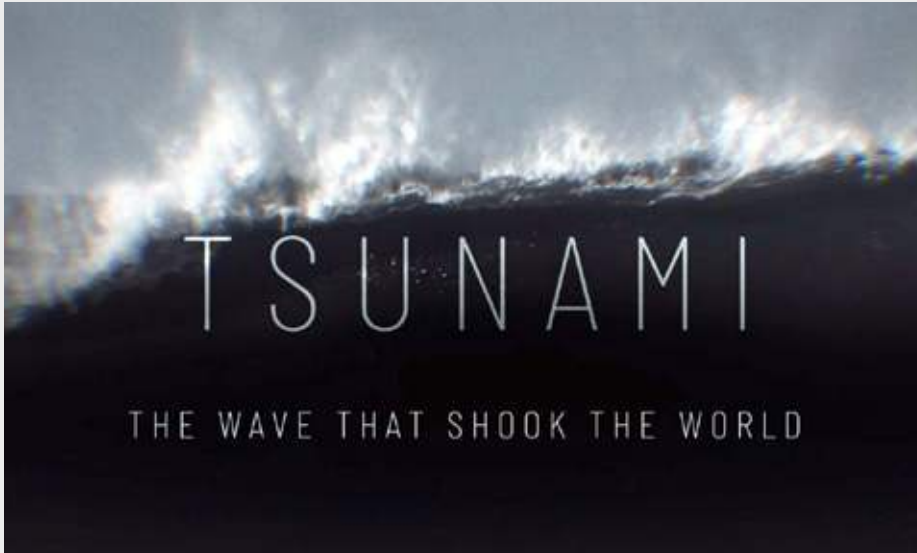
Coming to the rescue of *Life of Brian* when money fell through at the last minute, George Harrison offered to fund the entire film by mortgaging his house and his office to do so - as a huge fan of Monty Python, he credited their humour with saving his sanity while he was a Beatle and now it was his turn to pay them back. The film was a massive hit - so successful, in fact, that they decided to set up a company and HandMade Films was born.

In a rare moment in film history, HandMade dominated the British film scene with its ethos of making and releasing maverick films that others had rejected, from *Life of Brian*, *The Long Good Friday*, *Time Bandits* and Alan Bennett's triple BAFTA winner *A Private Function* to *Withnail and I* and the Oscar®-nominated *Mona Lisa* - Harrison's generosity in helping others fulfil their dreams and his hands-off approach allowed filmmakers to shine in their work. As its films won awards and launched careers, HandMade became more than a happy accident - it became a celebration of integrity and collaboration.

With unreleased archive interviews and footage with Harrison, new and exclusive interviews with BAFTA winner Michael Palin, Golden Globe® and Oscar® nominee Terry Gilliam, Oscar® nominee Richard E. Grant and Oscar® winner Neil Jordan, and unseen interviews with Golden Globe® and BAFTA winner Bob Hoskins, *An Accidental Studio* explores HandMade's baptism of fire and the risks it took in producing uniquely crafted and intelligent films.

Tsunami: The Wave that Changed the World

This powerful documentary commemorates the 20th anniversary of the devastating Indian Ocean Boxing Day tsunami and charts the moment-by-moment eruption of one of the biggest disasters in natural history.

The film tells the human story of how the catastrophic events unfolded during the morning of Boxing Day 2004 as powerful survivor stories are told through raw and personal testimony. A British holidaymaker remembers the desperate search for his brother in makeshift beachside morgues in Thailand; an Australian skipper describes his experience trying to control his boat off Phuket, with his three children on board, as it spins out of control on top of a gigantic tsunami wave; a Sri Lankan woman recalls being trapped inside an overturned railway carriage - with her parents and younger sister - hit by a wave and submerged in water.

Never-before-seen archive and reimagined visual effects show how trauma and resilience have defined a generation 20 years on - the documentary also combines gripping storytelling with groundbreaking GFX technology used as a powerful visual tool to help tell each stage of the story and bring the events of the 26th of December, 2004 to life.

Tsunami: The Wave That Shook The World features first-hand accounts from survivors and rescuers, providing a personal and emotional narrative of the events that unfolded on that fateful day while showcasing some of the most profound human attributes of fear, despair, grief, courage, hope, and ultimately redemption.

Contributors share photographs, diary extracts and artefacts recovered from the tsunami which have never been seen before, with some going back to the tsunami location and reuniting with others whose lives powerfully intersected in 2004 - but who have not seen each other for decades - in powerful and emotional reunions.
