Davina McCall and Nicky Campbell present the documentary series which aims to reunite family members desperate to find long-lost relatives after many years apart.

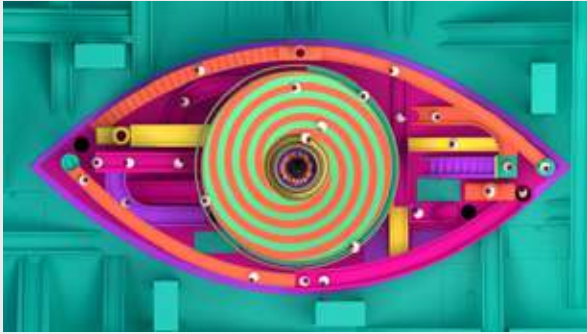
