ITV's propulsive thriller takes flight again in January with Jing Lusi reprising her role as DS Hana Li for a new investigation alongside guest star Martin Compston.

Joining Jing and Martin in the highly pressurised roller-coaster world of Red Eye are Lesley Sharp and Jemma Moore, who also return as Head of MI5 Madeline Delaney and journalist Jess Li.

Inside the US Embassy, the celebrations for a newly-appointed US Ambassador to London are shattered when a call threatening to blow a British plane out of the sky if anyone leaves triggers an immediate embassy lockdown and traps guests and staff inside.

That's when the murders begin, landing Hana Li, as a British cop, in a political and jurisdictional nightmare. Compelled to join forces with the Head of Embassy Security, Clay Brody, played by Martin Compston, a former colleague who once screwed her over, Hana has to see her way past her distrust of him and focus on the investigation... because this time it's personal. The plane that will be blown up is a government jet and Director General Madeline Delaney is onboard.

With a killer wreaking havoc inside the Embassy and evading them at every turn, Hana and Brody must discover who is behind the treacherous plot before time runs out for the hostages within the Embassy and the passengers on board Delaney's plane.

Commissioned by ITV's Director of Drama Polly Hill, the high-octane drama launched last year with audiences in excess of eight million viewers and 29.3 million streams on ITvX, making Red Eye one of ITV's top-ten dramas of 2024.

Red Eye is produced by Wales-based independent production company Bad Wolf with Peter A Dowling (Black and Blue, Flightplan), crafting and writing the intense and ambitious thriller full of his signature twists and turns. Jingan Young has written the third episode with Peter.

Kieron Hawkes (Power Book IV, Fortitude) returns to direct Episodes 1-3, with Camilla Strøm Henriksen (Grace, The Suspect) directing Episodes 4-6.

Red Eye consists of six new episodes.

Bad Wolf is the Sony Pictures Television-backed company founded in 2015 by Jane Tranter and Julie Gardner, who are the producers of Doctor Who, Industry, The Winter King, His Dark Materials, I Hate Suzie, and A Discovery of Witches.

Award-winning producer Julie Gardner (I Hate Suzie, Doctor Who) executive produces the new series alongside Peter A Dowling and Lachlan MacKinnon (Industry, A Discovery of Witches). Chris May (Litvinenko, Doctor Who) has produced the series.

Drama

The Lady



From award-winning producer Left Bank Pictures, the company behind *The Crown*, comes this gripping drama that charts the extraordinary rise and fall of Jane Andrews from Buckingham Palace to convicted murderer.

Based upon true events surrounding Andrews' story, the partly fictionalised drama is written by Debbie O'Malley (*Payback*, *Humans*, *Harlots*) and directed by Lee Haven Jones (*The Feast*, *Cruel Love: The Ruth Ellis Story*, *Passenger*).

Mia McKenna-Bruce (EE BAFTA Rising Star Award winner 2024) brings compelling depth to Jane Andrews, a young working-class girl who, to the astonishment of her friends and family, became the then Duchess of York's dresser at Buckingham Palace. Moving amongst the highest social circles in Britain, Jane managed to secure a place in the upper classes but then lost her job with the Duchess after nine years of service.

Still reeling from her fall from grace, Jane went on to meet charismatic businessman Thomas Cressman and fell deeply in love - however, cracks soon began to develop in the romance Jane had pinned all her hopes on with disastrous consequences.

Joined by Natalie Dormer (*Game of Thrones*, *The Hunger Games*) as Sarah and Ed Speleers (*Outlander*, *Downton Abbey*) as Thomas Cressman. *The Lady* examines ambition, class and identity against the backdrop of the British establishment.

The series also features a stellar line-up of acting talent including Philip Glenister, Claire Skinner, Laura Aikman, Ophelia Lovibond, Mark Stanley, Daniel Ryan and Sean Teale.

Shaun Evans (Until I Kill You, Endeavour, Vigil), Romola Garai (The Years, The Hour), and Zahra Ahmadi star in a gripping thriller about trust, truth, and the personal cost of secrecy in the modern intelligence world.

Written by award-winning playwright and screenwriter David Eldridge and directed by BAFTA and Emmy nominee Julian Jarrold, the series is set against the backdrop of MI5 and explores the fragile, tangled web of human relationships, where loyalty and deception collide.

At the heart of the story is John Hughes (Evans), a mid-career MI5 officer navigating a rapidly evolving intelligence landscape while struggling to keep his personal life intact. Acting on a hunch, John meets a British-Iranian man with links to the Stockport gangland who claims to have intelligence about an imminent plot on UK soil. When the encounter takes an unexpected turn, John finds himself under internal investigation, facing scrutiny from his superiors including Simone Grant (Nikki Amuka-Bird), while his partner Claire (Garai) grapples with the secrecy that defines his world.

John's efforts to save his marriage are complicated by his inability to let the case go - when he meets Mehreen Askari-Evans (Zahra Ahmadi), an intelligence operative who is tasked with taking over John's duties, he finds an unlikely ally. As John becomes increasingly convinced of the involvement of a hardline faction of the Iranian regime, he also starts to worry there are enemies closer to home. Can he identify the target and avert the attack before it's too late?

Produced by Irma Inniss (Mr Loverman, The Bay), Betrayal stars Gamba Cole (The Outlaws, Three Little Birds), Omid Djalili (The Letter for the King, His Dark Materials), Matthew Tennyson (A Midsummer Night's Dream, Grantchester), Hayley Tamaddon (Unforgotten, Coronation Street), Anthony Flanagan (Protection, House of the Dragon), Paddy Rowan (G'wed, Four Lives), Waj Ali (Out There, Dead & Buried), Karim Kadjar (Wolf Hall), Emma Cunniffe (Suspect: The Shooting of Jean Charles de Menezes, The Long Shadow), Georgina Rylance (Benediction, Sherlock), Ben Lambert (Outlander, The Crown), Julia Watson (Doctor Who, Doctors) and Julian Wadham (Black Doves, The Crown), alongside newcomers Elham Karimpour, Aidan Rivers, Corin Silva, and Eliza Agrosoaie.

A gripping psychological thriller from the pen of acclaimed screenwriter George Kay (The Long Shadow, Hijack, Lupin) and starring Eve Myles and David Morrissey.

Set against the backdrop of a prestigious private school, a foreboding forest and the quiet sprawl of Bristol, *Gone* is a chilling mystery focusing on local headmaster Michael Polly, played by David Morrissey (*The Long Shadow*, *Sherwood*, *Britannia*), who becomes the prime suspect in his wife Sarah's disappearance.

An upstanding member of the community, Michael Polly is inscrutable and likes order and precision in his working life - until, that is, he encounters super bright and gutsy detective Annie Cassidy, played by Eve Myles (*The Crow Girl*, *Hijack*, *Torchwood*), and a compulsive game of cat and mouse begins as she chips away at his veneer in search of the truth.

With tension in the air, yet Polly not displaying any emotion, Annie's suspicions are heightened the more she investigates. Something in her gut tells her all is not what it seems - could he be capable of murder, and if so, why?

Sarah and Michael's daughter Alana, played by Emma Appleton (*The Road Trip*, *The Killing Kind*, *Lola*), is a teacher at the school making their involvement a real family affair.

Beneath the surface of the mystery, lies a deeper exploration of trauma, trust and the legacy of elite institutions.

Gone also stars Jennifer Macbeth, Arthur Hughes, Nicholas Nunn, Elliot Cowan, Billy Barratt, Rupert Evan, Jodie McNee, Oscar Batterham and Clare Higgins. George Kay is the co-creator, writer, and executive producer of Emmy Award-nominated returning series *Hijack* - he also created and wrote the Golden Globe and BAFTA-nominated and Critics Choice award winner *Lupin*. His other work includes BAFTA-winning series *The Long Shadow* and *Litvinenko*, which both aired on ITV and STV and streamed on ITvX and STV Player. George also wrote the International Emmy-nominated *Criminal*.

Gone is a fictional series, partly inspired by the book *To Hunt a Killer* and the career and work of Julie Mackay, a respected former Detective Superintendent for Gloucestershire Police, and ITV Crime Correspondent Robert Murphy, who has reported on some of the biggest and most complex cases in the West of England. Both Mackay and Murphy serve as consultants on the series.

The Party



Based on the acclaimed novel by Elizabeth Day, this drama stars Luke Evans as Martin Gilmour, a journalist shaped by his lifelong friendship with the wealthy and charismatic politician Ben Fitzmaurice, played by Tom Cullen.

Raised alone by his working-class mum Sylvia, played by BAFTA-winning Joanna Scanlan (*After Love*, *Riot Women*), Martin (Evans - *Nine Perfect Strangers*, *Murder Mystery*, the *Fast and Furious* franchise and ITV's *The Pembrokeshire Murders*) wins a scholarship to an elite boarding school, where he first meets Ben (Cullen - *The Gold*, *Trespasses*, *House of the Dragon*). They forge an unbreakable bond as Ben and the Fitzmaurices give Martin the sense of belonging he has always craved - in turn, Martin remains unflinchingly loyal to Ben through even the greatest crises.

Three decades on, Martin is invited to Ben's lavish birthday party at the Fitzmaurice's country pile - the news of the Conservative leader's resignation threatens to derail Ben's party as he considers announcing his intention to stand. Martin fears the publicity that Ben's bid would bring, dredging up the secrets of their past with tragic consequences...

The drama moves between the shocking events of the party and the police investigation that follows, with flashbacks to Martin and Ben's lives at school, university and London party days. What unfolds is a gripping exploration of identity, privilege and devotion combined with a tender ode to anyone who has fought to live authentically.

The Party is written and created for ITV by award-winning showrunner Sarah Solemani (*Chivalry*, *Ridley Road*, *Barry* as writer, acting credits *Chivalry*, *Bridget Jones: Mad About The Boy*), who also stars as Martin's pregnant wife Lucy. Lydia Leonard (*Ten Percent*, *Gentleman Jack*, *Wolf Hall*) plays Serena, Ben's formidable wife, while Lindsay Duncan (*The Morning Show*, *H is for Hawk*, *His Dark Materials*) and Douglas Hodge (*We Live in Time*, *Pillion*, *The Night Manager*, *The Great*, *I Hate Suzie Too*) play Ben's parents Lady Katherine and Lord George Fitzmaurice.

Also joining the cast are Amaka Okafor (*Secret Service*, *Black Rabbit*, *Bodies*), Bally Gill (*Slow Horses*, *Interview With The Vampire*), Sally Scott (*Crow Girl*, *Black Doves*, *The Tower*), Sam Troughton (*Lockerbie: A Search for Truth*, *Mank*, *Chernobyl*), Sinéad Matthews (*Down Cemetery Road*, *Hullraisers*, *The Crown*) and Rakie Ayola (*Falling*, *The Pact 2*, *Grace*).

Sarah Solemani and Elizabeth Day also act as executive producers together with Laura Cotton from World Productions.

The series will be directed by Viviane Andereggen (*Nine Bodies in a Mexican Morgue*, *Kleo*) with Richard Burrell (*Nine Bodies in a Mexican Morgue*, *All Creatures Great and Small*) producing.

The Party commenced filming in Wales during October 2025.

The series will be distributed by ITV Studios. The production has received support from the Welsh Government via Creative Wales.

Secret Service



Acclaimed award-winning actress Gemma Arterton (Funny Woman, The Critic) leads a stellar cast in a gripping espionage thriller adapted from ITV News anchor Tom Bradby's tense and timely novel and produced by Potboiler Productions.

Set against today's fraught political landscape, *Secret Service* explores long-standing tensions between Russia and the UK and raises pressing questions about foreign influence in British politics.

Joining Gemma is an exceptional ensemble cast: Rafe Spall (*The English*, *Jurassic World: Fallen Kingdom*), Mark Stanley (*Adolescence*, *Happy Valley*), Alex Kingston (*Douglas Is Cancelled*, *Doctor Who*), Roger Allam (*Endeavour*, *The Choral*), Amaka Okafor (*Bodies*, *The Responder*), Aoife Hinds (*Dune: Prophecy*, *The Long Call*), Rochenda Sandall (*Amandaland*, *The Rig*, *Line of Duty*), and Khalid Abdalla (*The Day of the Jackal*, *The Crown*).

The series follows Kate Henderson (Gemma Arterton), a senior MI6 officer whose outwardly ordinary life as a civil servant, wife to Stuart (Rafe Spall), and mother of two hides a high-stakes role - she heads the Russia Desk at the Secret Intelligence Service. When a covert operation reveals that a prominent UK politician may be a Russian asset, Kate is plunged into a dangerous race to uncover the truth. A brutal murder thrusts her team into the spotlight, forcing her to navigate a treacherous world of espionage while protecting her family and herself from the fallout.

Secret Service marks a creative reunion between Tom Bradby and Oscar winner James Marsh, the acclaimed director of *Man on Wire* and *The Theory of Everything*, following their successful collaboration on the feature film *Shadow Dancer*.

Adultery



A scandalous new drama written by award-winning Danny Brocklehurst and produced by Poison Pen Studios.

The series is led by Dominic Cooper and Romola Garai, who recently won an Olivier Award for her performance in *The Years*, alongside Shelley Conn (*Gen V*, *Bridgerton*), Matthew McNulty (*Domina*, *Deadwater Fell*), Andrew Knott (*Gavin & Stacey*, *Protection*), James Murray (*The Crown*, *Masters of the Air*), Charley Webb (*The Long Shadow*, *Better*) and many more.

The provocative love story raises questions about class, grief, and the effects of social media as it takes the viewer on a rollercoaster story of passion, parenthood, and peril as Tom Kirkman and Beth Brookes embark upon a passionate and intense love affair that threatens to uproot their whole lives. *Adultery* is naturally authentic and bristling with passion as it focuses upon two ordinary families and messy complications.

Adultery introduces us to Tom's 15-year-old daughter Jess, who has found love with schoolmate Ollie, and they can't take their hands off one another as love's young dream becomes all consuming. When Tom meets Ollie's mum Beth in the most unexpected of circumstances, the two families' lives are potentially turned upside down forever - will Tom and Beth be able to control their desires unlike their lovestruck teenagers?

Drama centred around DI Emma Crane and DI Tom Radley investigating a tragic murder in the fictional town of Wakestead - they quickly identify their main suspect, but an unexpected lead comes to light as the case progresses.

As Emma and Tom dig deeper, they uncover a web of lies, institutional cover-ups and moral compromise which forces Emma to question the people closest to her. Part propulsive mystery, part social commentary and part love story, *The Blame* will tackle big questions around policing and will take an unflinching look at who we can really trust.

Leading the cast is Michelle Keegan (*Fool Me Once*, *Brassic*) as DI Emma Crane - Douglas Booth (*The Sandman*, *The Dirt*) joins as DI Tom Radley, and Ian Hart (*Mr Bates vs. The Post Office*, *The Last Kingdom*) is DCI Kenneth Walker.

The Blame promises complex characters, unexpected twists, and a mystery at its core.

The story of three victims of John Worboys, one of the most prolific sex attackers in British history who was dubbed by the media as the Black Cab Rapist after preying on women under the cover of being a 'respectable' licensed taxi-cab driver.

Aimée-Ffion Edwards (Slow Horses, Peaky Blinders, Dreamland, Mr Burton) Miriam Petche (Industry) and Aasiya Shah (Raised by Wolves, Bloods, The Beast Must Die) play the women Worboys sexually assaulted, while Daniel Mays (Des, A Thousand Blows, The Long Shadow, Moonflower Murders) takes the role of John Worboys.

John Worboys was convicted in 2009 for sexually assaulting twelve women between 2006 and 2008, with their cases selected from a large number of suspected further victims - his modus operandi was to claim that he'd had a win at a casino or on the lottery, then persistently offer women he'd picked up in his cab after a night out a glass of champagne, which he'd laced with drugs and which rendered his victims unconscious.

The drama focuses on the ordeal of two of the women who reported sexual assaults by Worboys and how the Metropolitan Police failed to thoroughly investigate these women's allegations, leading them to feel that they were just not believed. Believe Me will relate how this left Worboys free to commit assaults undetected for many years - following his trial came the realisation that he was linked to allegations of further sexual offences against over a hundred women.

The two women then joined forces with solicitor Harriet Wistrich and Phillippa Kaufmann QC and decided to sue the Metropolitan Police under the Human Rights Act for their failure to properly conduct investigations into their allegations of sexual assault, leading to them being subjected to degrading treatment and contributing to their distress.

The drama highlights how these women fought against all odds to have their cases heard whilst looming in the background was Worboys' first parole hearing - unbelievably, eight years after he was convicted for his crimes, his victims were made to fight again to keep him behind bars.

The Dark

To herald the beginning of the new scheduling pattern, both soaps will mark the occasion in spectacular style as the combined production teams embark on an ambitious stunt that will have everlasting consequences for everyone involved.

The distinctive worlds of Emmerdale and Coronation Street will merge for one night only in a 'mash-up' of our two favourite communities.

The producers, scriptwriters and production teams have conceived an ingenious way of linking the two universes, but with characters then returning to the soaps they are renowned for inhabiting in Manchester and Yorkshire.
